SIR KARTRITE established the front and showed the way in hand just off the inside coming under coaxing near the quarter pole, spun two to three wide into upper stretch, dug in under threat to the outside, came out to look his main danger in the eye and gamely fended off that rival to prevail. VOLATILE SITUATION lunged outwards at the break, chased five wide throughout coming under coaxing at the five-sixteenths, dug in under a drive to issue a challenge through the final furlong latching on the leader to the outside, was lightly brushed by that rival a sixteenth out, dug in game to the finish but was ultimately repelled at the end. SKYTOWN chased four wide under encouragement from the five-sixteenths, continued four wide into upper stretch, kept on through to the finish to procure the show honors. LETS FIGHT got bumped at the start by OUTSOURCE, chased four then two wide under coaxing from the five-sixteenths, swung four wide into upper stretch and kept on to the finish. ROOFER got carried in at the start by A MILLION STORIES, chased along the inside down the backstretch and then two to three wide through the turn, went six wide into upper stretch and made no late headway. OUTSOURCE broke

in at the start bumping LETS FIGHT, chased four then five wide under a ride from the five-sixteenths, swung three wide for home and passed tired rivals. CHIEF LIAM chased along the inside, was in a tight seam along the rail and hit the fence near the three-eighths, then again went into a tight seam near the five-sixteenths and was forced to steady out along the inside at the five-sixteenths, spun just off the inside into upper stretch and tired. A MILLION STORIES broke in at the start carrying in ROOFER, chased just off the inside under urging from the five-sixteenths, went six to seven wide into upper stretch and made no impact. JOHN'S IN CHARGE chased three to four wide under a ride from the five-sixteenths, continued three to four wide into upper stretch and tired. FRAME UP shied in at the start, chased two to three wide coming under coaxing at the three-eighths, got steadied near the five-sixteenths, swung four wide for home and tired. FINES CREEK chased six then five wide coming under coaxing at the five-sixteenths, swung six wide into upper stretch, faltered in the drive. RIFF grew detached at the tail of the field when sluggish and climbing early on and got taken outside to the six path to avoid kickback, tucked three wide into the turn, continued three wide into upper stretch and trailed.
